Members discuss proposed church addition

Members of the building committee from Holy Trinity Parish Church in Kewaskum met Thursday with the Archdiocese Building Committee to have plans for a parish center approved. Joel Fleischman and Brian Wildt represented the committee. This latest artist drawing of the proposed project shows the parish center, including a gymnasium, being built between the church, right, and Holy Trinity School. An anonymous donor provided \$750,000 toward the project and another anonymous donation of \$250,000 was made to pay for the building's maintenance costs over the next 10 years. A fund drive is now underway to raise more than \$2 million to pay for the project and additional maintenance work at the church and school. Members of the building committee are waiting for a final decision from the diocese on the building plans.
