Additional Parking Spaces

We have created a great plan for an additional 21 parking spaces in front of HT School, along Main Street. This plan includes sharing a joint driveway with Wendy & Randy Dreher and Hair-on-Main, their business. This plan allows for safe traffic flow from west to east in front of HT School and will be a good start towards replacing parking spaces that are being taken up by our new Parish Center. This involves securing a 20' X 70' joint driveway easement with the Dreheres. This easement was completed this week. Question: The description of Angel Fund in a WE BELIEVE brochure states that \$100,000 would be ear-marked for On-Going Parish Costs and Tuition Assistance. Could you please explain "On-Going Parish Costs"?

Answer: The initial Angel Fund was created within the Faith in our Future campaign. Just as it is named, it is a fund to help our youth (Angels) become educated & knowledgeable Christians. The primary goal of the Angel Fund is to provide needs-based assistance to families who do not have the resources to pay full tuition for their children. The usage of the Angel Fund is determined on a case-by-case basis by our HT School Principal, HT School leadership and HT Finance Council. The privacy and confidentiality of the family is held in the highest priority.

Beyond tuition based assistance, in our WE BELIEVE campaign, we decided we'll allow usage of the fund for other need's based requirements for students as they may arise, (for instance books, supplies, special curriculum, etc. for our HT School and Religious Education Programs), but specifically focused on providing funding to those families who need that support. The term "on-going Parish costs" was included to allow for fund allocation beyond basic tuition fees.
